Building the foundation for lasting peace through the joy of sports and healthy interaction between young people from different religious and cultural backgrounds.


OUR VALUES


ACF Israel has been working since 1991 to build on its commitment to work towards the development of young people to help them build a shared vision of a stronger and safer world for everyone.

SPORT FOR PEACE

OUR VISION

This includes the building of a sports stadium and educational centre on a 40-hectare site donated by the Sarsur family. The site is located outside Tel Aviv in the neutral territory between the Arab Village of Kfar Kassem and the Jewish town of Rosh Haayin. The centre will be open to boys and girls from all religious backgrounds, who will be invited to come together to play football and participate in other sporting activities. The centre will provide sports coaching of the highest level, together with educational facilities and mentoring. Each team will be made up of children and coaches from a mix of religious backgrounds. They will work together to achieve sporting excellence and it is anticipated that they will also compete internationally against other young people from different countries.

A range of educational workshops and training programmes will be provided alongside the sports facilities, so that young people can learn to work together in peace and harmony and will carry this understanding throughout their lives to help to build a better world for future generations.

PEACE THROUGH ART

AIM

We are carrying out a number of workshops and activities whereby students from Jewish and Arab schools in Israel can work together in small cross-cultural groups to develop artwork that express their vision and feelings about peace and co-existence. Our aim is to promote the benefits of peaceful co-existence and to fight ignorance, intolerance and prejudice. By creating art competitions in areas of conflict, we believe we can break down old barriers to communication and cooperation and bring about new ways of thinking and co-existing. We believe that this will be a wonderful opportunity for young students who want to gain visibility for their artwork and to enable them to promote their ideas on national and international platforms. It will empower them to express their desires for positive change in today's world.

ANNUAL ART PRIZE COMPETITION

ACF "Peace through Art" project is an open art competition to Israeli High School students from diverse backgrounds to express their vision and feelings towards peace and co-existence.

We are delighted to announce that their first "Peace through Art" Prize on 4 and 5 May 2017 took place in Herzliya Israel. 80 excited students from the Arab New High School in Kfar Kassem and the Jewish Hayovel High School in Herzliya worked together in pairs, one Arab student and one Jewish student to produce an original piece of artwork with the theme "Together we are Stronger". Alongside their artwork, they have been asked to write a one-page description in English.

The first round of Judging took place in Israel and all the artwork has now arrived in London, where the winning three pairs will be chosen by the end of May. The winners will then come to London during the month of August for a one-week cultural tour.

The art prize will be awarded to the students who, in the judges' opinion, have not only produced a piece of original and well-designed artwork that encapsulates this year's theme, but are also able to demonstrate through their description, how they worked together cooperatively to come up with the ideas behind the work and how they brought their ideas to life.

The students chose different media in which to work, some painted or produced collages, whilst others demonstrated their creativity through photography.
